

# Upgrade Guide

FOR ORF ENTERPRISE EDITION 2.1 USERS

## ■ What Is This Guide About?

This guide provides step-by-step instructions for upgrading from ORF Enterprise Edition 2.0/2.0.1/2.0.2 to ORF Enterprise Edition 2.1.

**IMPORTANT:** If you installed ORF 2.0.2 using the patch instead of the full installer version, please see the special instructions for this case.

## ■ Preparing For The Upgrade

### CREATING A CONFIGURATION BACKUP

Although ORF's configuration is automatically transferred to the new version, you may find it more secure to create a backup for the case if the upgrade fails. The configuration consists of the following files:

- orfent.ini
- orfeeadm.ini
- orfelogy.ini
- orfestat.dat
- orfestts.dat
- greylist.abs
- aswl.abs

These files can be found on the program path (by default it is *\Program Files\ORF Enterprise Edition*). Some files may not be present on your system or may be located in a different folder, depending on your settings.

The configuration files can be restored manually if the update fails.

### PREPARING FOR THE SERVICE OUTAGE

The ORF update requires to restart the Microsoft IIS Administration Service and all dependent services, such as the World Wide Web, SMTP, FTP and Exchange services. The service restart is automatically performed by the Setup, but you may have to schedule the upgrade to the time when the service outage causes the least problems.

### CLOSING RUNNING APPLICATIONS

Before starting the upgrade, **close the following programs** if they are running:

- ORF Administration Tool
- ORF Log Viewer
- Windows Event Log Viewer MMC

- Windows Services MMC

If any of these applications are running, the installation will fail. It is recommended to exit from all running applications before installing version 2.1 to avoid possible conflicts.

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR 2.0.2 USERS

**IMPORTANT:** If you installed the ORF 2.0.2 bugfix patch instead of the ORF 2.0.2 full release, please follow the instructions below before starting the upgrade.

- 1) Get <http://www.vamsoft.com/orf/202instreg.zip>
- 2) Extract the *202instreg.reg* file from the ZIP archive and double-click or hit Enter on it to insert its contents to the registry.

If the above fails, please enter the required registry key manually.

- 1) Start 'regedit'
- 2) Select the *HKEY\_LOCAL\_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Vamsoft\ORFEE 2.0.2* branch
- 3) Select *Edit | New... String Value* and enter "InstalledVersion" (exactly in this format, without spaces) for the value name.
- 4) Double-click or hit Enter on the value and enter "2.0.2R" in the *Value Data* field.
- 5) Close 'regedit'.

## ■ Upgrading To Version 2.1

#### STARTING THE UPDATE

Run the installer of version 2.1 (*orfee-2.1-registered.exe*).

You can install the new release safely on the top of 2.0 (including 2.0.1 and 2.0.2), without uninstalling the previous version. Uninstallation of the previous version would result in losing your ORF configuration.

#### UPDATE PROCESS

The update is guided by the Upgrade Setup. No special configuration is required at this point, the Setup asks for standard installation parameters, such as the program directory and menu shortcut creation.

#### AFTER THE UPDATE

Start the *ORF Administration Tool* and restore the SMTP Module Bindings on the **Configuration / Global / Server bindings** page and press CTRL-S to save the configuration. Now you can start the ORF Service (F11).
